**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BANCROFT, MICHIGAN,
ADOPTING AN ORDINANCE TO BE KNOWN AS:**

Repealing of 1887 Acts Ordinance

The Village of Bancroft Ordains:

Sec. 1. Purpose:

An ordinance to repeal the Ordinances I thru XXIV of 1887 of the Village of Bancroft in their entirety.

Sec. 2. Ordinances Repealed:

I. Duties of Recorder; II. Speed of Trains; III. Duties of Fire Warden; IV. Animals at large and picketing of horses; V. License Auctions and Regulate Peddling; VI. License and Regulate Exhibitions; VII. Peace and Good Order; XIII. Gaming and Gift Enterprises; IX. Obstructing The Right of Way; X. Nuisance; XI. Erection/Placing of Wooden Buildings; XXII. Nightwatch and Night Police; XIII. Highway and Poll Tax Collection; XIV. Un-wholesome Trade and Nuisance; XV. Horse Racing/Riding to Fast; XVI. Imposing Costs for Fines by Courts; XVII. Children Jumping onto Moving vehicles; XVIII. Meeting Time of Council; XIX. Obstructing Sidewalks; XX. Protect Certain Trees; XXI. Suppress Vice and Immorality; XXII. Leaving Teams Unhitched; XXIII. Fire Department Duties; XXIV. Assessment/Collection of Taxes.

Sec. 3. Effective Date:

This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after its passage, as set forth hereafter.
