ORDINANCE NO. 202-94

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BANCROFT, MICHIGAN, ADOPTING AN ORDINANCE TO BE KNOWN AS:

Uniform Traffic Code

The Village of Bancroft Ordains:

SECTION 1. Code Adopted.

The uniform Traffic Code for cities, townships and villages promulgated by the Director of State Police and published in the 1979 edition of the Michigan Administrative Code and amendments as published in the Quarterly Supplement No. 5 to the 1979 edition of the Michigan Administrative Code, in accordance with Public Act 62 of 1956, State of Michigan, is hereby adopted by reference as in this ordinance modified.

SECION 2. Reference In Code.

Reference in the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Townships and Villages to "governmental unit" shall mean the Village of Bancroft.

SECTION 3. Conflicting Ordinances Repealed.

All traffic ordinances and other ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed in their entirety. With reference being made to Nos. 104-59, 100-63, and 124-70.

SECTION 4. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after its passage, as set forth hereafter.
