AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BANCROFT, MICHIGAN, AMENDING AN ORDINANCE KNOW AS:

AN ORDINANCE TO LICENSE AND REGULATE AUCTIONEERS and THOSE SELLING PROPERTY AT AUCTION.

THE Village of Bancroft ordains.

Section 1. Purpose:

The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Section 3 of ordinance no. 106-59.

Section 2. Amendment:

Section three (3) is repealed in its entirety, and replaced with the following:

Section 3. A fee of twenty five (\$25) dollars shall accompany said application for license, such fee shall be paid to the Village Clerk. If in all respects the provisions of this ordinance have been complied with by said applicant or applicants for such license, said Village Clerk shall issue such license. Said license shall not be granted for more than two (2) days beginning with the first day of the sale mentioned in such application for license, nor shall any auction sale be conducted before eight (8) o'clock a.m. and no latter than nine (9) o'clock p.m.

Section 3. Severability:

This ordinance is hereby declared severable. If any part or clause is adjudge invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4. Effective Date:

This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after its passage, as set forth hereafter:
