ORDINANCE #228-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BANCROFT, MICHIGAN KNOWN AS:

GARBAGE/RUBBISH ORDINANCE.

THE VILLAGE OF BANCROFT ORDAINS:

Section 1. Definitions

- A. "Garbage" means rejected food wastes, including waste accumulation of animal, fruit or vegetable matter used or intended for food, or wastes that attend the preparation, use, cooking, dealing in or storing of meat, fish, fowl, fruit or vegetables.
- B. "Rubbish" means nonputrescible solid waste, excluding ashes, consisting of both combustible or noncombustible waste, such as paper, cardboard, tin cans, yard clippings, wood, grass, bedding, crockery or litter of any kind, that will be detrimental to the public health and safety.

Section 2. Removal Times

The Bancroft Village Council shall set by resolution the times for garbage/rubbish removal within the Village, hereinafter known as "pick-up day".

Section 3. Container Placement:

Containers for the containment of garbage/rubbish shall be placed within the street right of way no earlier than the day prior to the "pick-up day" as established by the Village Council.

Section 4. Container Removal

Containers for the containment of garbage/rubbish shall be removed from the street right of way no later than the day following the "pick-up day" as established by the Village Council.

Section 5. Failure To Remove:

Whenever an owner or occupant shall fail to remove brush, tree limbs, etc from the right of way within 72 hours following written notice from the Village, the Village may remove said items and bill the property owner the actual costs of the removal.

Section 6. Violations:

Violation of this Ordinance is a civil infraction punishable as follows:

- A. First offense shall be a written warning;
- B. Second offense within a one year period shall be a fine of not less than \$25.00;

C. Third offense within a one year period shall be a fine of not less than \$50.00.

Section 7. Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after its passage, as set forth hereafter.

I, Shana Post, being the Clerk of the Village of Bancroft, MI does hearby cause to be published the following synopsis of recently adopted ordinances of the Village of Bancroft, pursuant to M.S.A. 5.1274.

At the regular meeting of the Bancroft Village Council, held on June 11, 2003 the following Village ordinances were adopted:

228-03 Garbage/RubbishOrdinance - The Village shall set by resolution the times for garbage/rubbish removal within the village, hereinafter known as "pick-up" day. Containers for the containment of garbage/rubbish shall be placed within the street of way no earlier than the day prior to pick up. Containers for the containment of garbage/rubbish shall be removed from the street no later than the day following the pick-up day. Failure to remove brush, tree limbs, etc from the right of way within 72 hours following a written notice from the Village, owner shall be billed for cost of removal. Violations are as follows; 1st offense-written warning, 2nd offence-within a one year period shall be fined not less than \$25.00, 3rd offence-within a one year period shall be fined not less than \$50.00.

Water Ordinance #229-03 Operation, Repair & Mgmt shall be under supervision and control of the Village Council. Council shall pass all Ordinances, and make such rules and regulations as are needed so as to provide for the safe, economical and efficient manangement thereof. Rates to be charged for connections, service, etc are hereby set forth.
