- 2. The Clerk and Treasurer shall be appointed to two (2) year terms.
- 3. This ordinance shall take effect 45 days after the date of adoption unless a petition signed by not less than Ten Percent (10%) of the registered electors of the Village is filed with the Village Clerk within the 45 day period, in which case this ordinance takes effect upon approval at an election held on the question.
