WHEREAS, the Wilbur Bills Elementary School has been an important and historic part of the community of the Village of Bancroft and the closure of the school saddened Village residents and families, we understood time brings about change;

WHEREAS, the school and land constitutes a significant portion of the Village's total acreage and the property has been off of Village tax rolls for approximately sixty years;

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED:

That the Village of Bancroft looks forward to working with the School District and future buyer(s) in the possible redevelopment of the land, consistent with the Village of Bancroft Land Use Plan, in order to return the property to a revenue generating status.

Adopted at a special meeting of the Bancroft Village Council held on the 6th day of January, 2016.


