

RESOLUTION 2016-3

WHEREAS, the Village of Bancroft maintains a system of roads to facilitate the transportation needs of its residents, its businesses, and the region, as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned roads are subject to ordinary use by vehicles of varying weights and to large variances in temperature; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Bancroft has developed a long-term plan for the maintenance and replacement of the aforementioned roads in order to continue to meet the increasing needs of a modern transportation system; and,

THEN NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved, that the Village of Bancroft does hereby declare its support for the following project: Restoration and rehabilitation of a 0.27 mile stretch of Grand River Road commencing from the western edge of the intersection with North Shiawassee Street east to the intersection of Grand River Street at the eastern edge of the Village limits,

And, furthermore, the Village of Bancroft will provide for the necessary funding to supplement the construction of the aforementioned project.




