July 2022

July has come and gone. A lot of hours were spent on mechanical issues, trying to get the vac. Trailer functional. Most of the trailer has been disassembled to fix mechanical issues. This is an ongoing project that will take some time to finish. There hasn't been a whole lot of new business in the month of July, just maintaining, and keeping things looking nice. Here are some other projects I have been working on:

- 1- Maintaining and testing the water. The arsenic this month was 2 parts per billion, well under the M.C.L. of 10 parts per billion. The treatment plant is functioning as it should.
- 2- Monthly sampling.
- 3- Some payments for delinquent water bills came in and almost everyone is back on.
- 4- Filled the new planter boxes at the community garden with soil.
- 5- Sweep floors, clean bathroom, keep things maintained at the D.P.W. and village office
- 6- Mowing and maintaining village properties.
- 7- Change oil on Zero turn mower, check blades. Grease.
- 8- Keep the water totes at the community garden full.
- 9- Tree trimming
- 10- Maintain park bathrooms, emptying trash cans at the ball field and the park.
- 11- Keeping equipment clean and working properly.
- 12- There was some storm damage to trees that fell in the roadway that needed attention.
- 13- Power outages and generator maintenance.
- 14- Work on auto dialer and communication system at the treatment plant/ well house.

A notable oversight regarding the water system, the disinfection byproducts testing which can only be tested in the month of June was sent in late. This is a minor violation with E.G.L.E. We will have to inform the public of this violation on next year's consumer confidence report. I was unaware of the strict parameters of this testing procedure. Having gained knowledge from this mishap, it won't happen again. If you have any questions or concerns, please let someone at the Village offices know. We will do our best to take care of it.
