DPW Report: DPW has been very busy. Started new driveway at the Villages Municipal Complex going to water department. He has been fixing and seeding from last year. Fan clutch is bad on the truck and needs to be fixed. The Village shut off water with delinquent bills. Most of those paid the same day water was shut off. They will be shutting off water again soon.

Police Report: Chief Wilburn presented police report.

Public Comments: Luke Darrow spoke about the emergency management which consist of tornado sirens. Their goal is to link both new and existing sirens into a centralized system at the 911 center. The center would integrate directly with the National Weather Service. As of right now, a firefighter has to run to the hall and set off the siren. Luke also spoke about the 1.5 millage that will be on the election ballot. This 1.5 mills will bring in \$163,966 the first year to help cover equipment such as air bottles, extraction tools, firefighter's gear, trucks and maintenance that are nearing the end of the NFPA compliance as well as state required trainings.
